

School Emergency Closure Guide

We recognise that the decision to close a school in the event of an emergency (e.g. snow) significantly impacts upon you as parents and guardians. In the event of a closure, we may decide to delay the start of the school day (i.e. open later) or close the school for the day. The decision will be made as soon as possible once the conditions have been fully assessed.

This leaflet outlines the agreed procedure which all schools are asked to follow.

In line with County Guidance given to Schools, in the event of snowfall conditions we will:

Before school hours start, we will assess if the roads are safe for children & staff to travel to school.

Seek approval from the Governing Body to authorise the decision to close.

Notify Cornwall Council and the local radio stations.

We will also put a notice on the home page of the website and a post on the school Facebook page.

In the event of heavy snowfall during the school day: we will undertake a risk assessment, using common sense to determine whether it is feasible for children and staff to remain in the school and notify parents through the text messaging system.
