

Dear Parents and Carers,

I do hope you and your family are well. This letter is to inform you about a few changes for September to keep your child safe at school.

Start of term September 2020

We have two INSET days on Thursday 3rd September and Friday 4th September.

Term will start on Monday 7th September

As mentioned in our last letter we will have a transition week from Monday 7th September – Friday 11th September. Children in currently in Year 2 will start the week with Mrs Miles and gradually transition to class 2. By Thursday they will be in Class 2 full time.

If your child is in reception next year, then they will be in for mornings only the first week back transitioning into class 1.

Please be aware that from September, attendance of school is compulsory once more and we will be need to report and follow up absences as before.

Coming into school

School for both classes will start at 8:45 and finish at 3pm. We do not need to stagger starts and breaks as we have the space to do this.

Pre School and class 1 – please continue to line up outside the green gate and the teachers will come and meet you as they have during this time. At the ned of the day (or session for pre-school), please queue outside the green gate and the children will be brought out to you.

Class 2 – please queue by the benches. We will be opening the small gate to the playground along the top bank of the school. The class teacher will opening this gate at 8:45 and class 2 will come into the school via the door near their class.

Once in school the children will be in their class 'bubbles'. They will have separate breaks in different playgrounds, staggered lunchtime and staggered afternoon breaks as needed.

Every school will feel different to how we used to work and an aspect prevention of spread of the virus affects is the children not being able to mix with other classes. This is regrettable but necessary. A real strength of Madron is how the children still play with much younger children even in Year 6. We will find creative ways of keeping this link with across class going! Watch this space!





Let's hope that things progress so we can be working in the 'old' way soon.

We will be temperature checking your child from September as they come into school. As we have more children back it is important to be vigilant in our approach. Children with a temperature (and any other symptoms) will not be able to stay in school.

Pre School Arrangements

We will start gradually in September building up to full time provision. This will give us time to get to know your child again after the long break which will be beneficial for the education and well-being.

So for weeks beginning Monday 7th September, Monday 14th September and Monday 21st September we are open as follows:

All children - morning from 8:45 -11:45, Monday - Friday

From Monday 28th September we are open as follows:

Two Year olds - Monday -Friday 8:45-11:45

Three and four year old – Monday and Tuesday all day, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday half days 8:45 – 11:45

Free School Meals over the Summer

We have set up the voucher scheme for the 5 weeks of the Summer break from Monday 27^{th} July – Monday 24^{th} August. Mrs Gill is in on Monday 20^{th} July and Tuesday 21^{st} July to answer any queries on this.

Holiday Club

We are running our Holiday club in partnership with Penlee Cluster for 5 weeks this Summer and this will be based a Madron Daniel C of E School. This will start on Monday 27th July for 5 weeks and at present is only on Monday and Fridays. **Please book your place by Tuesday 22nd July.** We hope this provision will support you as a family during this time.
