

Food packages for Free School Meal (FSM) Children Easter break arrangements

Please note this is for FSM Pupil Premium Children not Universal Free School Meals provided for class 1. We have sent you a text if you are eligible.

We are collecting the food packages on Tuesday 14th April.

To collect your food package and comply with social distancing please follow the instruction below:

- Please come to collect food packages from school between 11:45 and 12:45pm Tuesday 14th April
- The food packages will be on the benches, set 2m apart, outside the school building. Please collect package and then leave the site. DO NOT COME INTO THE SCHOOL BUILDING. A member of school staff will tick you off the list, so we keep a record of who has collected their food package.
- Please observe social distancing, keeping a minimum 2m distance from other parents and carers. Please ensure that only ONE person at a time is coming through the school gate.
- Please wait outside the gates if another parent or carer is collecting a food package so that you keep at least 2m apart. If there are other parents and carers collecting then queue outside the school gates, at least 2m apart.
- As soon as you get home, wash your hands for least 20 seconds.
- We will distribute any uncollected packages if you are unable to get to school. We will be knocking on your door and then leaving the package outside, always keeping a minimum 2m distance between yourself and others.
- We have opted for food packages this week I will inform you if arrangements change.
