Cornwall Rural Community Charity

Free cooking advice and meals –helping out with the cost of living don't miss out!

This project will be teaching small groups how to cook economic, healthy meals in batches and how to store and freeze them safely.

We will be running these free sessions in the Landithy Hall in Madron on Thursdays from the second week in November. The classes will be taken by a good fun professional local chef and will run for about two and a half hours around the middle of the day. They will finish well in time for school pick up.

The intention is to pass on cooking skills to help families cook cheaply and well, but by using as little expensive electric or gas as possible.

The groups will be of 6-8 people and each group will be taught once a week for three weeks. At each session not only will the participants be taught useful skills and tips but they will also go home with meals for a family of four, for three or four days. All of the ingredients will be free.

Every three weeks another group will start. Please pop into the office and let us know if you are interested
