Curriculum Intent

At Madron Daniel C of E Primary School, we want the children develop a sense of curiosity about the art. We approach art teaching in an enquiry based way questioning how techniques are used to create effect and exploring these with the children.

Our Art curriculum includes looking at works of local artists past and present, so children learn about Cornish artists and gain a sense of the uniqueness of this part of Great Britain as an inspiration for artists. We also study National and International artists so children learn about artists not only in their immediate community but also artists in the wider world.

We build up subject specific vocabulary in each unit of work and build in outcomes for the children to share their knowledge so they can use their newly acquired vocabulary,

We use our extensive outdoor setting at Madron for developing our Young Artists, providing opportunities to connect with the outdoors,. This benefits children's well being and inspires the children to become courageous advocates for the natural world

By the end of KS1 our Young Artists:

- Be able to think quickly and develop a more rigorous understanding of art and design.

- Will have developed their techniques, including their control and their use of materials, with creativity, experimentation and an increasing awareness of different kinds of art, craft and design.
